

## **Ordinance No. 571**

### **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OSCEOLA, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SEWER**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the City Council of the City of Osceola, Iowa:

**SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED.** Section 99.03(01) A-E of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Osceola, Iowa is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

- A. Residential Users - \$3.77 per 1,000 gallons
- B. Commercial Users - \$3.91 per 1,000 gallons
- C. Industrial Class A Users - \$4.11 per 1,000 gallons
- D. Industrial Class B Users - \$4.26 per 1,000 gallons
- E. High Volume Rate - \$4.26 per 1,000 gallons

**SECTION 2. SECTION MODIFIED.** Section 99.05 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Osceola, Iowa is amended by adding the following subsection 1:

1. **Water Service Prohibited.** It shall be prohibited for water service to be active at any house, building, or property used for human occupancy, employment, recreation or other purposes where the building sewer is unable to receive and/or convey sewage to the public sewer or onsite system. In such event, the City will give notice to Osceola Water Works that water services shall be terminated until the building sewer is repaired or replaced in accordance with the provisions of the State Plumbing Code and the Provisions of Chapter 135 of this Code of Ordinances. This prohibition shall not apply to water service for irrigation, livestock, construction, or any other purpose deemed appropriate by the City.

**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.


**SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE.** Section 1 of this ordinance shall be in effect following its final passage, approval and publication for the June 2017 utility usage, to be

bill in July, 2017. Section 2 of this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
