**ORDINANCE NO. 602** AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OSCEOLA, IOWA, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 22 PERTAINING TO THE LIBRARY BOARD BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Osceola, Iowa: SECTION 1. NEW SECTION. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Osceola, Iowa, is amended by striking Chapters 22.02, 22.03, and 22.04 and the following adopted in lieu thereof: 22.02 LIBRARY TRUSTEES. The Board of Trustees of the Library, hereinafter referred to as the Board, consists of five resident members appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Council. 22.03 QUALIFICATIONS OF TRUSTEES. All resident members of the Board shall be bona fide citizens and residents of the City. Members shall be over the age of eighteen (18) years. 22.04 ORGANIZATION OF THE BOARD. The organization of the Board shall be as follows: 1. Term of Office. All appointments to the Board shall be for six years, except to fill vacancies. Each term shall commence on July 1. Appointments shall be made every two years of one-third the total number or as near as possible, to stagger the terms. 2. Vacancies. The position of any resident Trustee shall be vacated if such member moves permanently from the City. The position of any Trustee shall be deemed vacated if such member is absent from six (6) consecutive regular meetings of the Board, except in the case of sickness or temporary absence from the City. Vacancies in the Board shall be filled in the same manner as an original appointment except that the new Trustee shall fill out the unexpired term for which the appointment is made. 3. Compensation. Trustees shall receive no compensation for their services. SECTION 2. REPEAL. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed. SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-18 Setting date for public hearing on designation of the Autumn Ridge Urban Renewal Area and on urban renewal plan and project WHEREAS, a proposal has been made which shows the desirability of designating certain property within the City of Osceola as the Autumn Ridge Urban Renewal Area, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 403, Code of Iowa; and WHEREAS, a proposal has been submitted to the Council under which an area within the description set out in Exhibit A would be designated an urban renewal area; and WHEREAS, this Council is desirous of obtaining as much information as possible from the residents of the City

before making this designation; and WHEREAS, a proposed urban renewal plan for a project within that proposed urban renewal area has been prepared and it is now necessary that a date be set for a public hearing on the designation of the area and on that plan and project; and WHEREAS, the proposed plan shall be presented to the City's Plan and Zoning Commission, in accordance with Section 403.5 of the Code of Iowa, for a determination whether the proposed plan is in conformity with the general plan for the development of the City; NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Osceola, Iowa, as follows: Section 1. This Council will meet at the City Hall Council Chambers, Osceola, Iowa, on the 2nd day of April, 2019, at 7:00 o'clock p.m., at which time and place it will hold a public hearing on the designation of the proposed Autumn Ridge Urban Renewal Area described in the preamble hereof and on the proposed urban renewal plan and project for said Area. Section 2. The City Clerk shall publish notice of said hearing, the same being in the form attached to this resolution, which publication shall be made in a legal newspaper of general circulation in Osceola, which publication shall be not less than four (4) nor more than twenty (20) days before the date set for the hearing. Section 3. Pursuant to Section 403.5 of the Code of Iowa, Ty Wheeler is hereby designated as the City's representative in connection with the consultation process which is required under that section of the urban renewal law. NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON DESIGNATION OF THE AUTUMN RIDGE URBAN RENEWAL AREA AND ON PROPOSED URBAN RENEWAL PLAN AND PROJECT Notice Is Hereby Given: That at 7:00 o'clock p.m., at the City Hall Council Chambers, Osceola, Iowa, on the 2nd day of April, 2019, the City Council of the City of Osceola will hold a public hearing on the question of designating as the Autumn Ridge Urban Renewal Area, pursuant to Chapter 403, Code of Iowa, certain property generally described as follows: Known as the Autumn Ridge Subdivision, located in the 18-72-25 section of the City, more specifically shown on the map in the urban renewal plan for the Autumn Ridge Urban Renewal Area on file in the office of the City Clerk, and with a legal description of Parcel K of the SW Fractional 1/4 of the NW Fractional 1/4 of Section 18-72-25, City of Osceola, Clarke County, Iowa. The subject matter of the public hearing will also include a proposed urban renewal plan and project for the Autumn Ridge Urban Renewal Area identified above, pursuant to Chapter 403, Code of Iowa, a copy of which plan is on file for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk. The general scope of the proposed urban renewal plan, as more specifically described therein, includes the following: Increasing the tax base and promoting economic growth in Osceola by encouraging new residential development. The primary provision of the plan is a proposed development agreement between the City and Autumn Ridge Development, L.C., related to the construction by the developer of a 39-unit residential development, including 9 duplexes and 21 single family houses, and related infrastructure. The City will agree to use incremental property tax revenues to be generated by the project to reimburse the developer for infrastructure construction costs in the amount of approximately \$430,000 and, in addition, to provide funds to benefit housing for low and moderate income families in the City. At the hearing any interested person may file written objections or comments and may be heard with respect to the subject matter of the hearing.
