The City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of the proposed hearing, setting forth the purpose, the time when and place where the hearing will be held, by publication at least once and not less than 4 nor more than 20 days before the date of the hearing, in a legal newspaper which has a general circulation in the City.

Resolution to Approve Urban Renewal Plan Amendment for the Osceola Urban Renewal Area WHEREAS, as a preliminary step to exercising the authority conferred upon Iowa cities by Chapter 403 of the Code of Iowa (the "Urban Renewal Law"), a municipality must adopt a resolution finding that one or more slums, blighted or economic development areas exist in the municipality and that the rehabilitation, conservation, redevelopment, development or a combination thereof, of such area or areas is necessary in the interest of the public health, safety or welfare of the residents of the municipality; and WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Osceola, Iowa (the "City") by prior resolution established the Osceola Urban Renewal Area (the "Urban Renewal Area") and adopted an urban renewal plan (the "Plan") for the governance of initiatives and projects therein; and WHEREAS, an amendment (the "Amendment") to the Plan has been prepared which authorizes the undertaking of urban renewal projects in the Urban Renewal Area consisting of (1) providing tax increment financing support to Hometown Housing, LLC (the "Developer") in connection with the construction by the Developer of housing affordable to families of low and moderate income; (2) using tax increment financing to assist the City in paying the costs of acquiring certain real property, demolishing existing structures and constructing housing affordable to families of low and moderate income thereon; (3) using tax increment financing to pay the costs of acquiring certain real property situated at 101 and 103 West Washington Street and undertaking the demolition of a fire-damaged building to promote future economic development thereon; and (4) using tax increment financing to pay the costs of the City's Osceola Chamber Main Street Support Program; and WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing by the City Council on the proposed Amendment was heretofore given in strict compliance with the provisions of Chapter 403 of the Code of Iowa, and the City Council has conducted said hearing on August 15, 2023; and WHEREAS, copies of the Amendment, notice of public hearing and notice of a consultation meeting with respect to the Amendment were mailed to Clarke County and the Clarke Community School District; the consultation meeting was held on the 31st day of July, 2023; and responses to any comments or recommendations received following the consultation meeting were made as required by law; NOW, THEREFORE, It Is Resolved by the City Council of the City of Osceola, Iowa, as follows: Section 1. The Amendment attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby in all respects approved. Section 2. It is hereby determined by this City Council as follows: A. The activities proposed under the Amendment conform to the general plan for the development of the City. B. The economic development initiatives and projects proposed under the Amendment are necessary and appropriate to facilitate the proper growth and development of the City in accordance with sound planning standards and local community objectives. C. It is not anticipated that families will be displaced as a result of the City's undertakings under the Amendment. Should such issues arise,

then the City will ensure that a feasible method exists to carry out any relocations without undue hardship to the displaced and into safe, decent, affordable and sanitary housing. Section 3. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict. There was no action taken at this time regarding Consideration and Possible Action Regarding the Resolution Authorizing Economic Development Grant to Hometown Housing, LLC for workforce housing new construction.
