## Waste Water Lab Analyst/Tech

Under general supervision; collects samples and performs a variety of chemical and microbiological tests to determine the quality of City wastewater, before and after treatment; performs related work duties as required and assigned.

Performs a variety of laboratory analyses, including organic and inorganic chemical, and microbiological analyses of industrial and domestic wastewater, sludge, groundwater, well water, surface water, or potable water; develops techniques to improve laboratory analysis procedures; advises and assist other operations personnel in conducting routine lab work relating to plant operation; plans and carries out sampling and analysis studies to access stream water quality, industrial waste, extra strength contributors, and potable water; records data and prepares periodic reports and related materials in accordance with State and Federal requirements; develops, and maintains laboratory safety programs; maintains quality assurance program; develops new methods for laboratory analysis according to EPA guidelines.

A full job description and complete list of duties, requirements, and working conditions can be found in City Hall. Requires a Grade I wastewater operator's license within 2 years of employment. Starting wage is \$25/hr; however, may be negotiable if applicant processes a Grade II or higher waste water operator license. The City of Osceola is an Equal Opportunity Employer.
